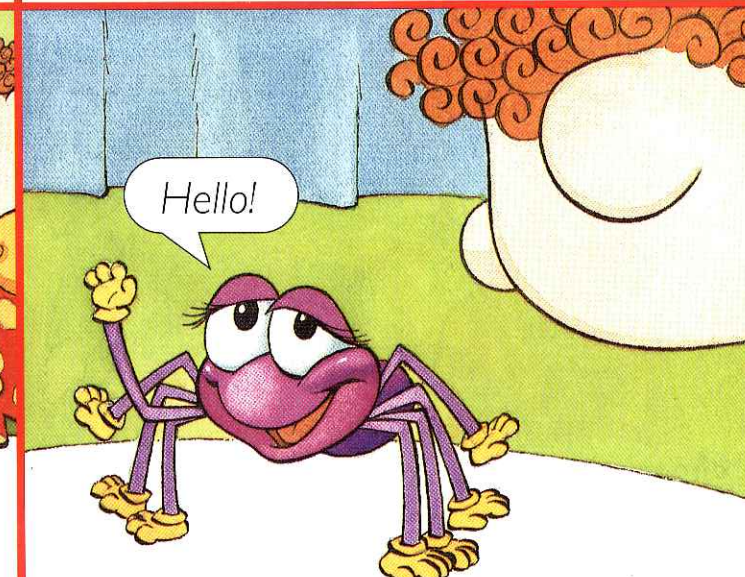
This is number 9 Roundabout Street. There's a big popcorn tree in the yard. There are lollipop flowers and cotton candy flowers! It's a beautiful yard!
