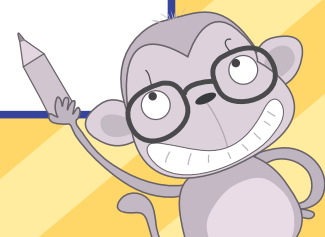

Countable nouns are those we can count. They have singular and plural forms. We can use **a/an** or **numbers** before them.

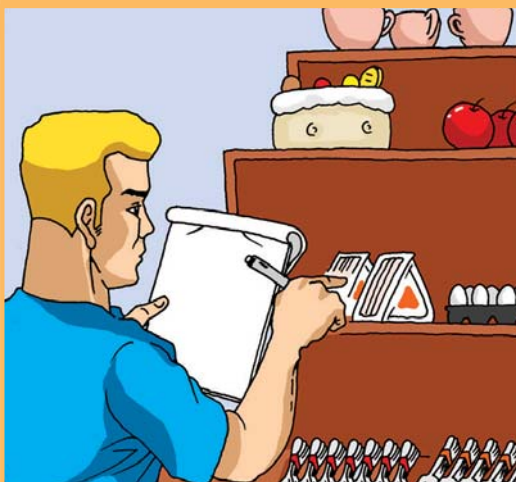
a sandwich **an** apple **six** spoons

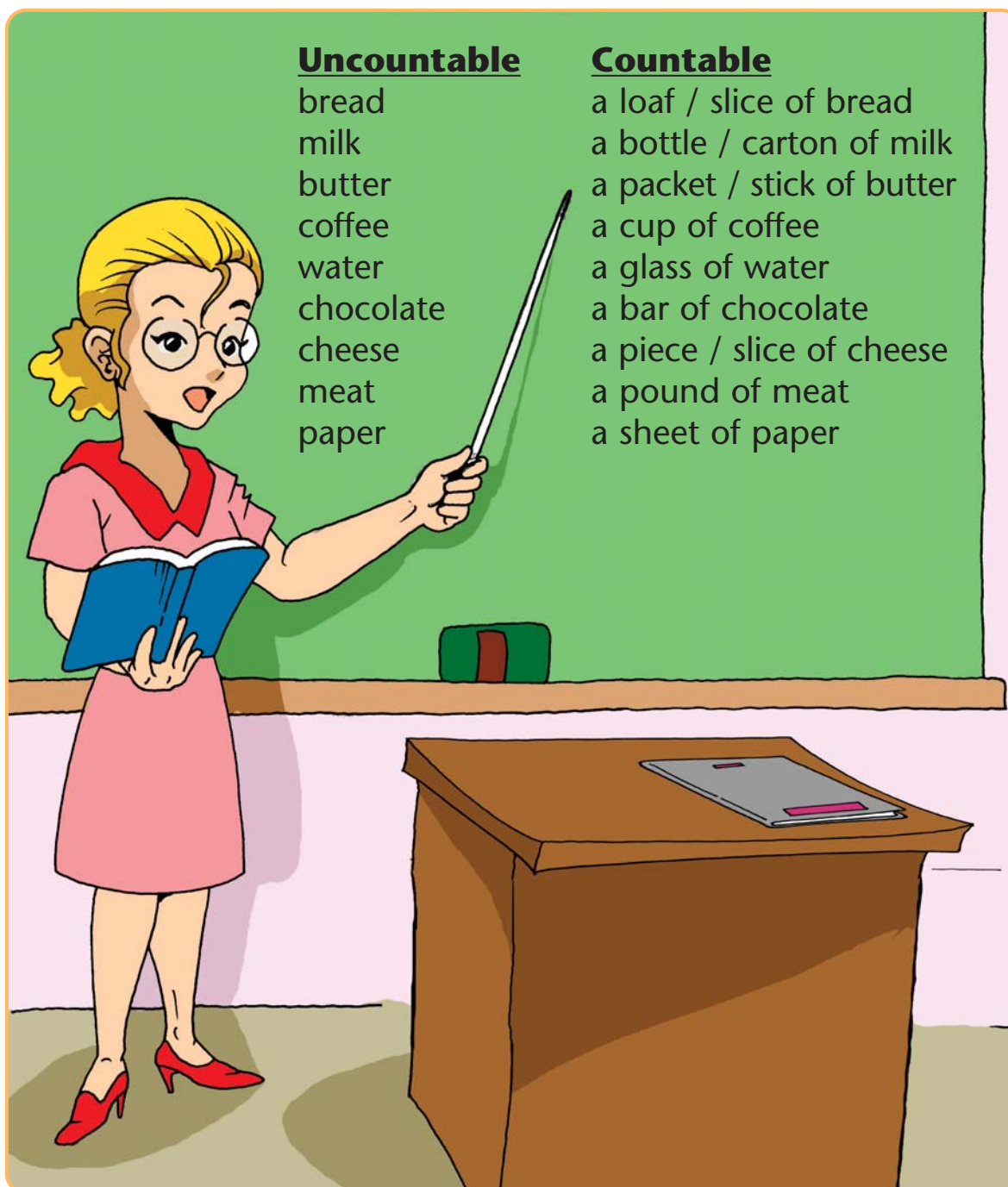
Countable Nouns
