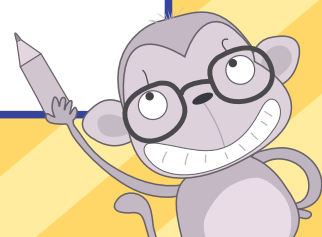

## Grammar Rules

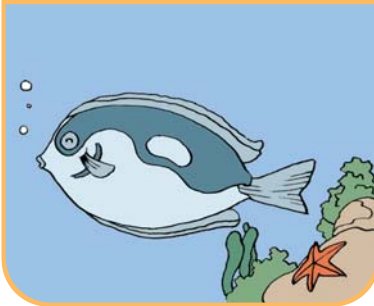
Articles — the words **a**, **an**, and **the**

A / An (indefinite article = any one): **a** fish, **an** animal, **a** robot, **an** onion

The (definite article = a specific one, one of a kind, or all of a kind):  
**the** fish in the sea, **the** animals in the zoo, **the** sky, **the** piano

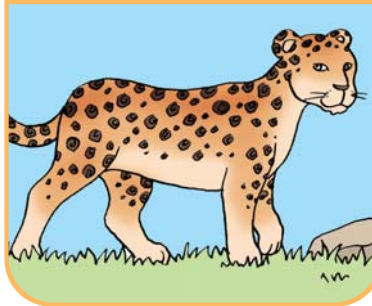

Hello, I'm **a** fish.  
I live in **the** sea.

**an animal**



Hello, I'm **an** animal.  
I live on **the** land.

**the sun**

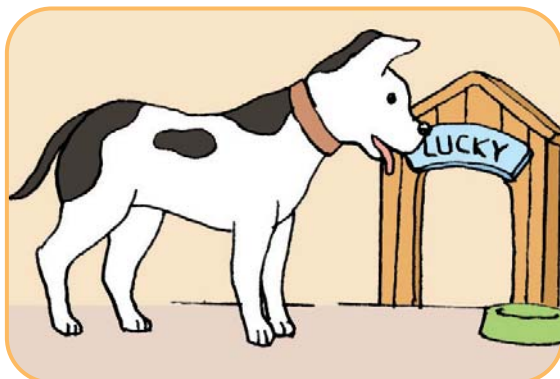


Hello, I'm **the** sun.  
I live up in **the** sky.

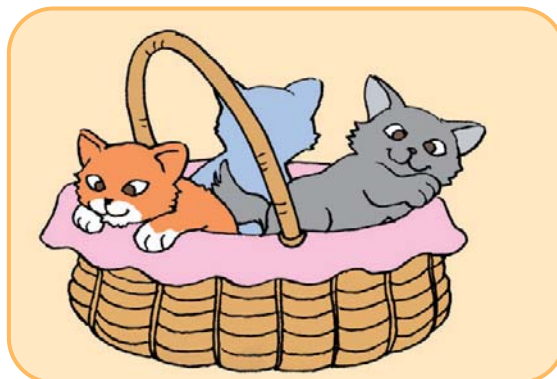
## Grammar Corner

**The** dog is black and white.



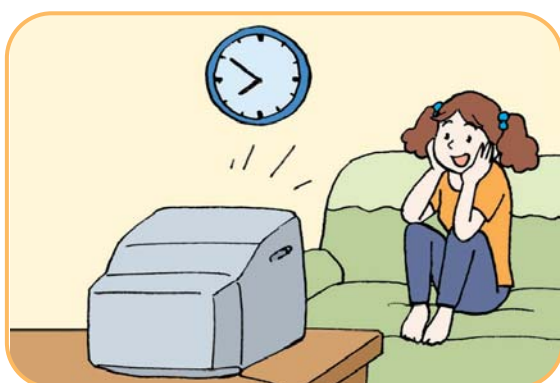
These are cats.  
**The** cats are in the basket.



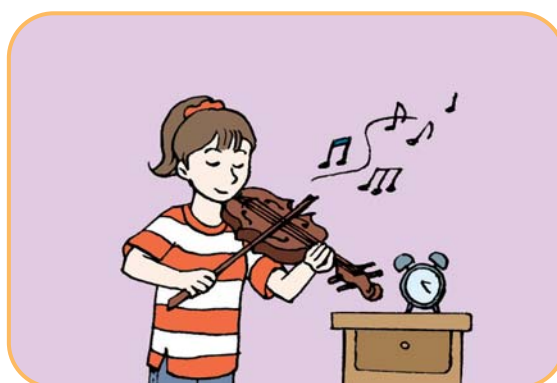
I jog in **the** morning.

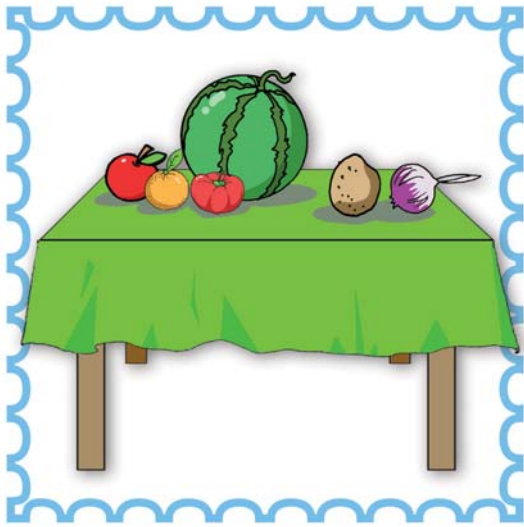
