

Using the Spelling Tutor Cards

The **Spelling Tutor** cards feature the same QR codes that are found throughout the Student Edition. When students scan the codes with a mobile device, they have access to **Spelling Tutor**, a fun, interactive way for them to study their weekly spelling words. The **Spelling Tutor** cards can be printed and used in a variety of ways.

Option 1: School/Home Connection

At the beginning of each unit, print and copy the corresponding **Spelling Tutor** card for that unit. Make enough copies for each student in your class and distribute the cards to students. Have students write their names on the cards and store them in folders, envelopes, or zip-top bags that they take home. Encourage students to use the cards to study their spelling words at home or at school when they do not have access to a *Spelling Connections* Student Edition.

Option 2: Literacy Center

As students complete a unit of study, add the corresponding **Spelling Tutor** card to a literacy center or work station in your classroom. You may wish to print the cards on cardstock or laminate them for durability. Encourage students to work individually or with a partner to use **Spelling Tutor** to study their spelling words.

IMPORTANT NOTE: When accessing QR codes, connection to a Wi-Fi network is recommended to avoid using your cellular data and incurring overage fees.
