2. A spring **tide** is when high tides rise higher than usual and low tides **fall** lower than usual.
3. In both cases, the forces of **gravity** from the Sun and the Moon are pulling in a straight **line**, which causes higher high tides and lower low tides than usual.
4. When this happens, the **force** of gravity pulling on the surface of the Earth's ocean is **weaker**.
5. So, the best time to go **fishing** is during a low tide, and the best of the best is during a **spring** low tide.
