WHAT YOU NEED: a coin, game pieces

1. Play rock-paper-scissors to decide who goes first.
2. The student who wins flips a coin and moves the game piece.
[Front side] Move forward 1 space.
[Back side] Move forward 2 spaces.
3. Say the word where the game piece lands. Then say the matching sentence using the same colored box.
4. The student who finishes first wins the game.
