### Lesson 1

- A Target sounds, letters, and their representative words are initially introduced. Students will learn the letter-sound relationships by listening and repeating.
- B A phonics-instructive chant is provided that includes learned sounds and words. Students will more closely familiarize themselves with the unit's targets by sounding them out through chanting.
- C Letter-picture association maps are presented to introduce students to more representative words and pictures of each target sound. Students will learn more words and strengthen their grasp of the unit's target letters and sounds by listening, pointing, and repeating.
- D The stroke order of each target letter is displayed along with photos of their representative words. After writing out the letters, students will have a chance to practice vocalizing them.
- E An activity sheet is provided for each unit. Students will consolidate their comprehension of the unit's targets through the completion of various activities.
