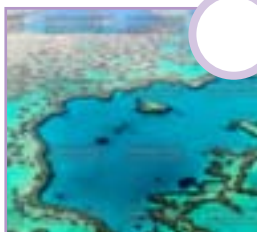

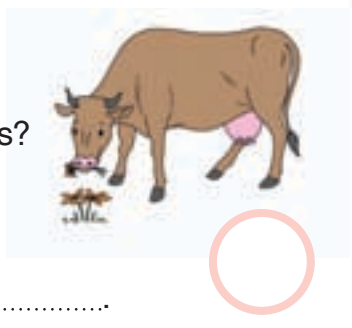

Stay Safe When Camping

**A safety kit**

When you go camping, bring a safety kit with you. Your kit should have Band-Aids, bandages, toilet paper and medicines. You can use the safety kit for small cuts and burns.

- ✓ get inside (but not in a tent!)
- ✓ find a low place (lightning strikes tall things)
- ✓ go downhill
- ✓ move fast
- ✗ don't go in the water
