B: It's a circle.







Ooops! I'm sorry, Miss Muffet!




The Itsy-Bitsy Spider

Things you need



paper plate



wool



toothpick

- Make holes evenly around the edge of the paper plate using a toothpick.
- 2 Thread a long strand of wool through the first hole and tie a knot.
- 3 Thread the long strand of wool between each hole to make a web.
- 4 Tie a knot in the wool at the last hole.

- Make a hole in the bottom of a paper cup using a toothpick.
- 2 Tie a bell to the bottom of a long string and then thread the string through the hole so that the bell is inside the cup.
- 3 Tie a knot in the string so that the bell doesn't fall out of the cup.
- 4 Decorate the bell and ring it.





Things you need













Play-Doh

ice cream sticks

colored papers

crayons

scissors

- Oross two ice cream sticks and glue them together to make the scarecrow's body.
