paint



white pencil
crayon



glue

- 1 Draw the outline of a tree trunk and branches on the black paper with the white pencil crayon.
- 2 Cover the tree branches with glue.
- 3 Stick pieces of pop-corn along the branches like leaves. Then wait for the glue to dry.
- 4 Add green leaves to your tree with washable paint and gently paint the pop-corn leaves.

B: She is my sister, (name).



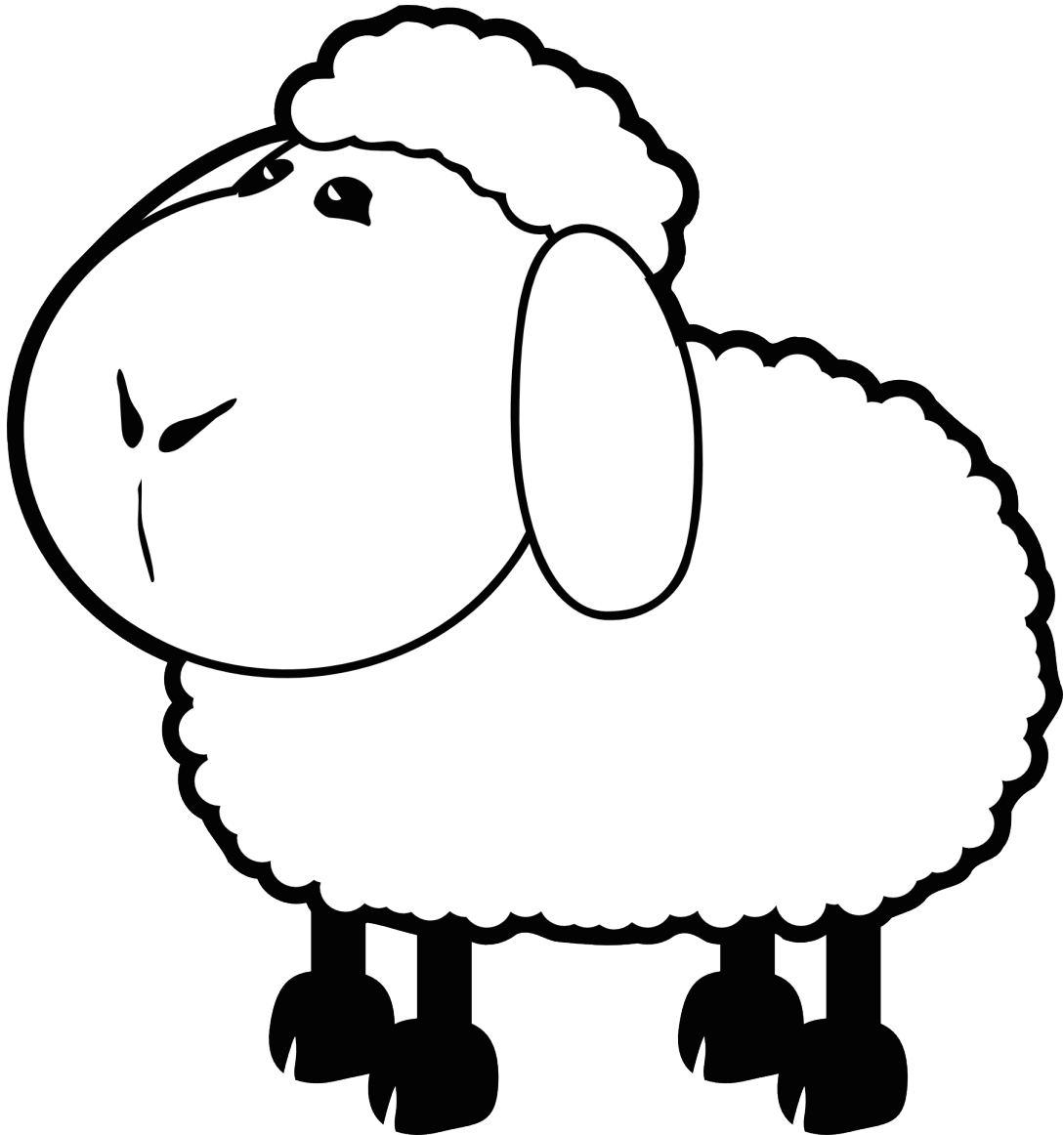

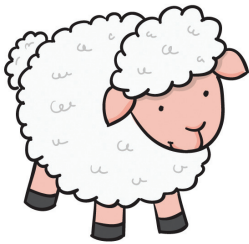

B: Yes, you're hot. /

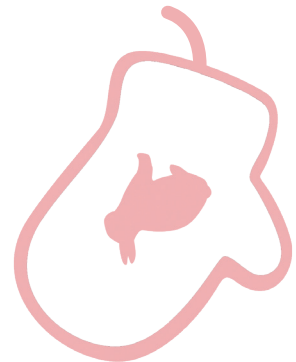
