A. Summary

1. Book Summary

A handsome prince named Tamino gets lost in a magic land. He faints while running away from a snake. Three magic ladies appear and kill the snake. When Tamino wakes up, he sees a strange man called Papageno who has feathers all over him. The three ladies show Tamino a picture of the beautiful daughter of the Queen of the Night. The queen asks Tamino to save her daughter, Pamina, from an evil king. To help him, he is given a magic flute, which can change people's hearts.

Tamino and Papageno go to the castle of King Sarastro, where Pamina is being held. At the castle, Tamino is captured by Sarastro's servant Monostatos, who wants Pamina for himself. Sarastro tells Tamino he can marry Pamina, and Papageno can marry a servant girl called Papagena, if they pass three tests, which they do. The Queen of the Night comes to the castle and asks Pamina to kill the king, but she can't do it. Then the queen asks Monostatos to do it, and in return she will give him Pamina. But they are stopped by Sarastro, who throws them into the darkness forever.

2. Chapter Summary

► Chapter 1

One day, a handsome prince called Tamino gets lost in a magic land and is chased by a snake. He screams for help before he faints. Three servants of the Queen of the Night appear and kill the snake using magic. The three magic ladies all want to stay with the handsome man lying on the ground, but in the end they all leave.

► Chapter 2

Tamino wakes up and sees a man with feathers all over him. The man is singing that he is Papageno, a bird hunter, and that he is looking for a very pretty girl to make his wife. Tamino asks him if he killed the snake, and Papageno lies and says yes. The three ladies have just then returned and they hear Papageno. They use magic to lock his mouth so he can't talk, and they tell Tamino that they killed the snake. They then show him a picture of a beautiful girl called Pamina. Tamino falls in love with her right away. Then the Queen of the Night appears and asks Tamino to save her daughter, Pamina, from an evil king.

► Chapter 3

Tamino agrees to save the princess. To help him, the three ladies give him a magic flute that can change people's hearts. Then they free Papageno from their magic. Papageno promises never to tell lies again. The ladies ask him to go with Tamino, and they give him some magic silver bells to protect him. They also send three magic boys who can fly to show the men the way to the king's castle.

► Chapter 4

The magic boys take Tamino and Papageno to King Sarastro's castle. Sarastro's servant Monostatos is with the princess. He is in love with her, but she doesn't love him. When Papageno gets into the castle and meets Monostatos, they are both surprised and they flee. Later, Papageno finds Pamina again and tells her that Tamino is in love with her and is coming to save her.

► Chapter 5

Tamino is still outside the castle trying to get in. He tries two of the castle's three gates, but they won't open. At the third, he meets an old man. He tells the old man that he has come to save the princess. The old man tells him that the queen has tricked him and that Sarastro is not evil but is a wise and good man. Tamino doesn't know what to believe. He asks why the king took the princess, and the old man says it is a secret.

► Chapter 6

Tamino doesn't know what to do, so he starts playing the magic flute. Pamina and Papageno hear the music and run to meet him, but Monostatos stops them on their way. He calls his big, strong servants, but they start to dance when Papageno shakes his magic bells. Pamina and Papageno escape, but then they run into Sarastro. Pamina tells the king that they are running away because Monostatos loves her but she doesn't love him. Just then, Monostatos comes in, and with him is Tamino. He tells Sarastro that Tamino has come to steal the princess away.

► Chapter 7

Sarastro tells the prince and princess they can get married if Tamino and Papageno pass three tests. He promises to give Papageno a servant girl named Papagena as wife if he passes the tests. To get through the first two tests, the men must not talk. They pass the first test by not answering the questions that three ladies ask them. Elsewhere in the castle, the Queen of the Night appears and catches Monostatos trying to kiss Pamina while she is resting. Monostatos flees, and the queen gives Pamina a knife to kill Sarastro. Pamina

doesn't want to, and she goes to find Tamino. Pamina and an old woman appear at the room where Tamino and Papageno are, and they ask the men questions. Tamino can't talk, and Pamina thinks he doesn't love her. She runs away and thinks of killing herself. The men have passed the second test.

► Chapter 8

The old woman asks Papageno to marry her and love her forever. Thinking that no one will ever love him, Papageno agrees. Suddenly, the woman changes into the young and beautiful Papagena. But she is immediately taken away by two servants. Tamino goes to find Pamina and tells her he loves her. They then have to walk through some caves with fire and water for the last test. Tamino plays the magic flute, and they get through the third test safely. Back in the castle, Papageno takes the magic boys' advice and plays the magic bells to bring back Papagena. Before the young couples can get married, the Queen of the Night appears with Monostatos. She promises to give Monostatos her daughter if he kills her enemy, Sarastro. But the king stops them and throws them into darkness forever with a flash of bright light. It is a happy ending for all.

B. Background and Themes

- ★ Love: Tamino falls in love with Pamina, and Papageno falls in love with Papagena.
- ★ Deceit: The Queen of the Night tricks Tamino into saving Pamina in order to kill Sarastro.
- ★ Magic: Many characters have magical powers, and Tamino and Papageno are helped by a magic flute and magic bells.
- ★ Reward: Tamino gets Pamina and Papageno gets Papagena after overcoming difficulties.
