Introduction	1.Greeting - Greet the class.  2.Review - Check homework Have students (Ss) complete Unit 10 Word worksheet to review the key words from the previous lesson.	WB (pp. 22-23) Unit 10 Word worksheet	3 min.
Main Lesson	1. Warm-Up  - Have Ss open to p. 70 in their SB.  - Look and read the title together.  - Have Ss discuss the picture.  - Ask Ss the warm-up question.  - Have Ss predict what the unit will be about.  [Optional Activity with PPT material]  - Direct Ss' attention to the PPT.  - Briefly introduce the topic of the video clip.  - Have Ss watch the video clip.  - Have Ss discuss the video clip and ask follow-up questions. Key Words <ul> <li>Have Ss look at p. 71 in their SB.</li> <li>Have Ss listen to the CD (Track 32) and look at the pictures.</li> <li>Have Ss listen to the CD again and repeat the words.</li> <li>As a class, have Ss read each word aloud.</li> <li>Give Ss enough time to complete Activity B.</li> <li>Check the answers together.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	SB (p. 71) CD (Track 32)	8 min.



	<ul> <li>3. Reading <ul> <li>Have Ss listen to the CD (Track 33).</li> <li>Introduce the new words and phrases from the section, More Words and Phrases.</li> <li>Have Ss listen to the CD (Track 34) and read aloud by repeating after each sentence.</li> <li>Ask Ss to clarify the main idea of the reading passage.</li> <li>Ask Ss a few detailed comprehension questions.</li> <li>Have Ss work in pairs to discuss the "While you read" question, and then ask a few Ss to share their answers with the class.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	SB (pp. 72-73) CD (Track 33) CD (Track 34)	10 min.
	[Optional Activity with PPT material]  - Prepare the Further Reading handout before class.  - Direct Ss' attention to the PPT.  - As a class, have Ss read the title aloud.  - Give Ss the Further Reading handout.  - Briefly introduce the topic of the Further Reading passage.  - Have Ss discuss the pictures in the PPT slide.  - Have Ss independently read the passage.  - Have Ss discuss the passage and ask follow-up questions. 	<ul> <li>4. Comprehension</li> <li>Give Ss enough time to complete Comprehension Activities</li> <li>A-D.</li> <li>Check the answers together.</li> </ul>	SB (pp. 74-75)	10 min.
	<ul> <li>5. Wrap-Up: Link to Write</li> <li>Explain the theme of the writing activity and go over the example if one has been provided.</li> <li>Give Ss enough time to write their own paragraphs.</li> <li>Have Ss work in pairs to discuss their answers.</li> <li>Ask a few Ss to share their paragraph with the class.</li> </ul>	SB (p. 75)	10 min.
Closure	1. Review - Ask Ss to discuss what they have learned in class today.  2. Homework - Assign homework from the workbook.	WB (pp. 24-25)	3 min.
