Dad is watering the grass.



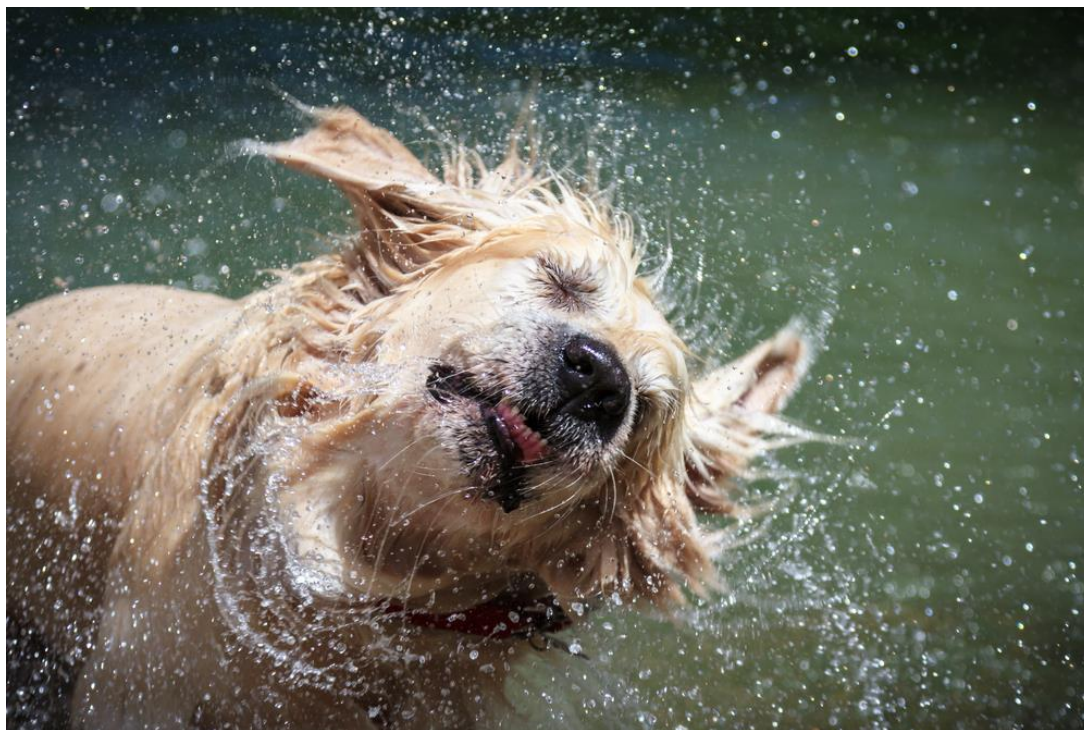
leaf
