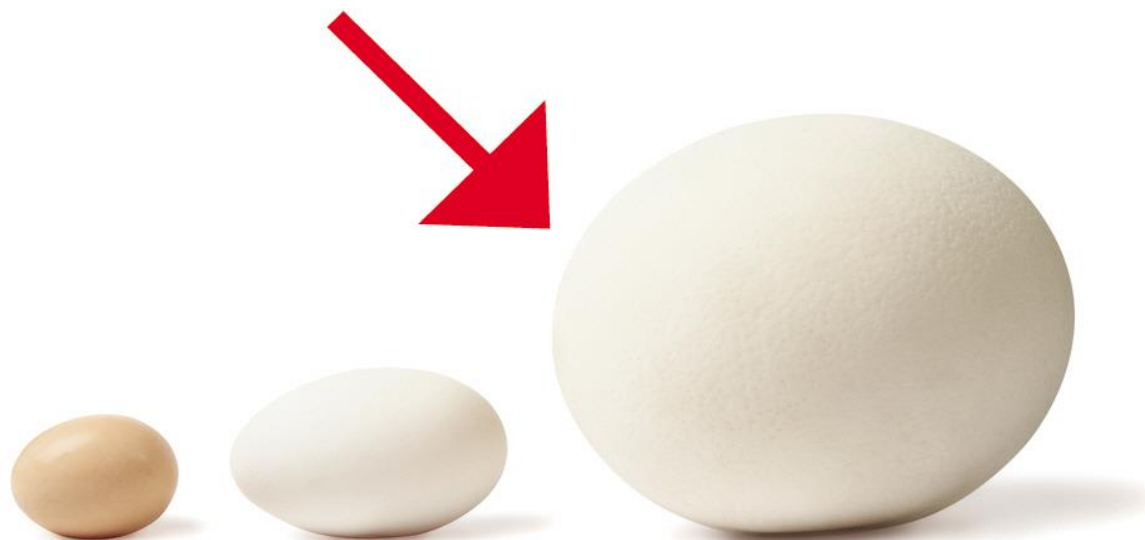




**balloon**

along a path.**



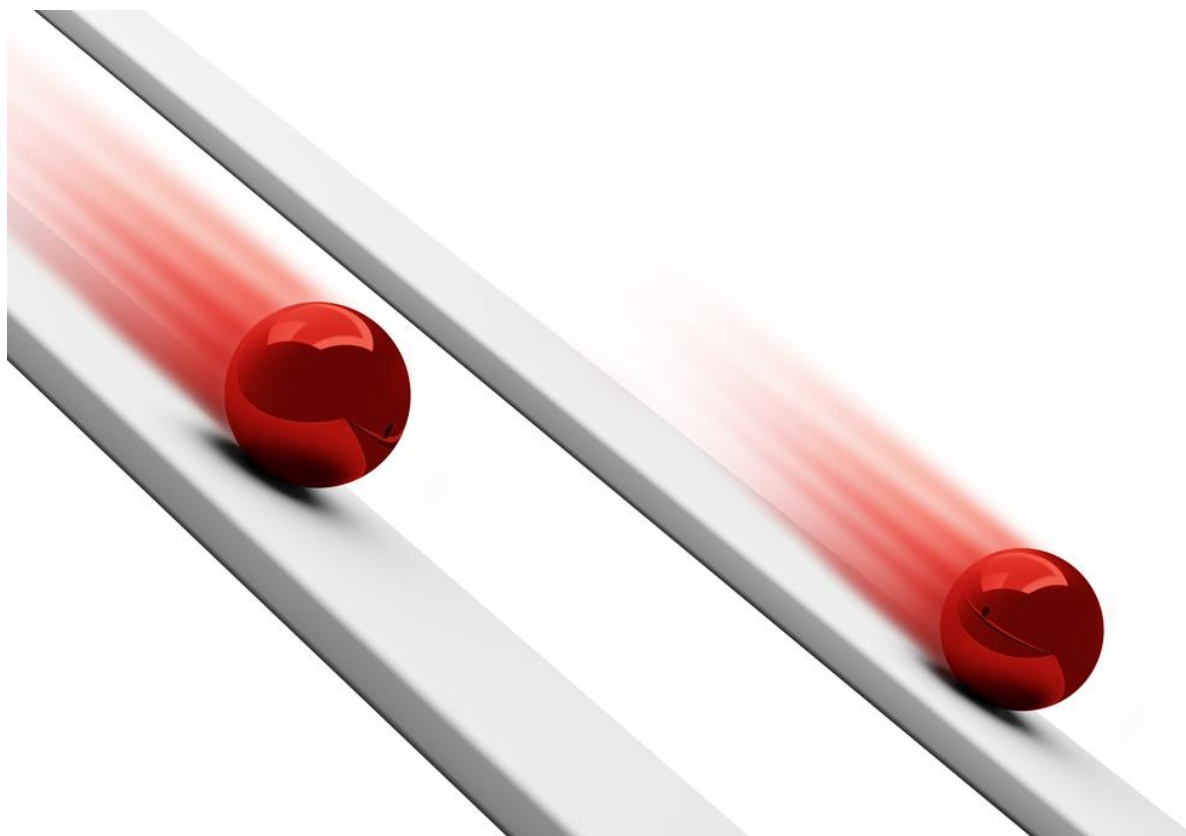
**mud**

**roll**

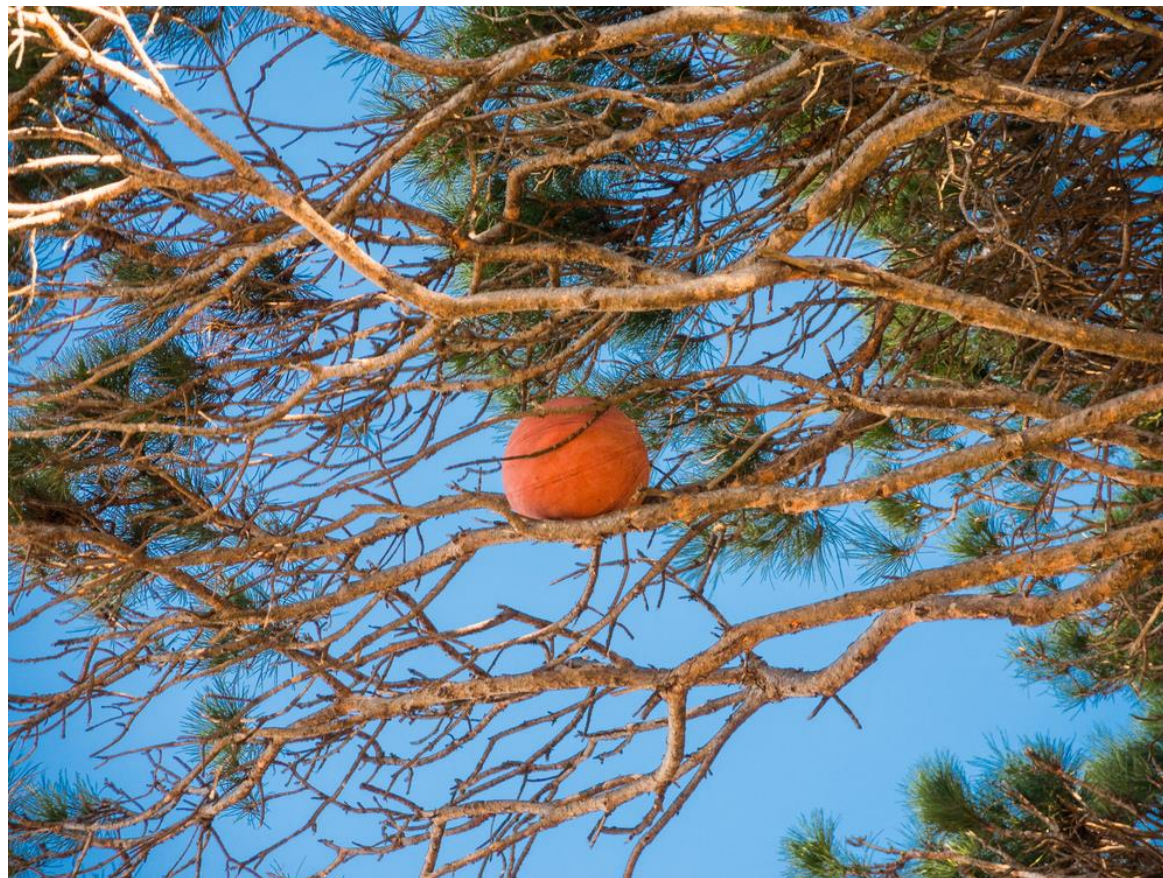
**It rolled out of the mud.**





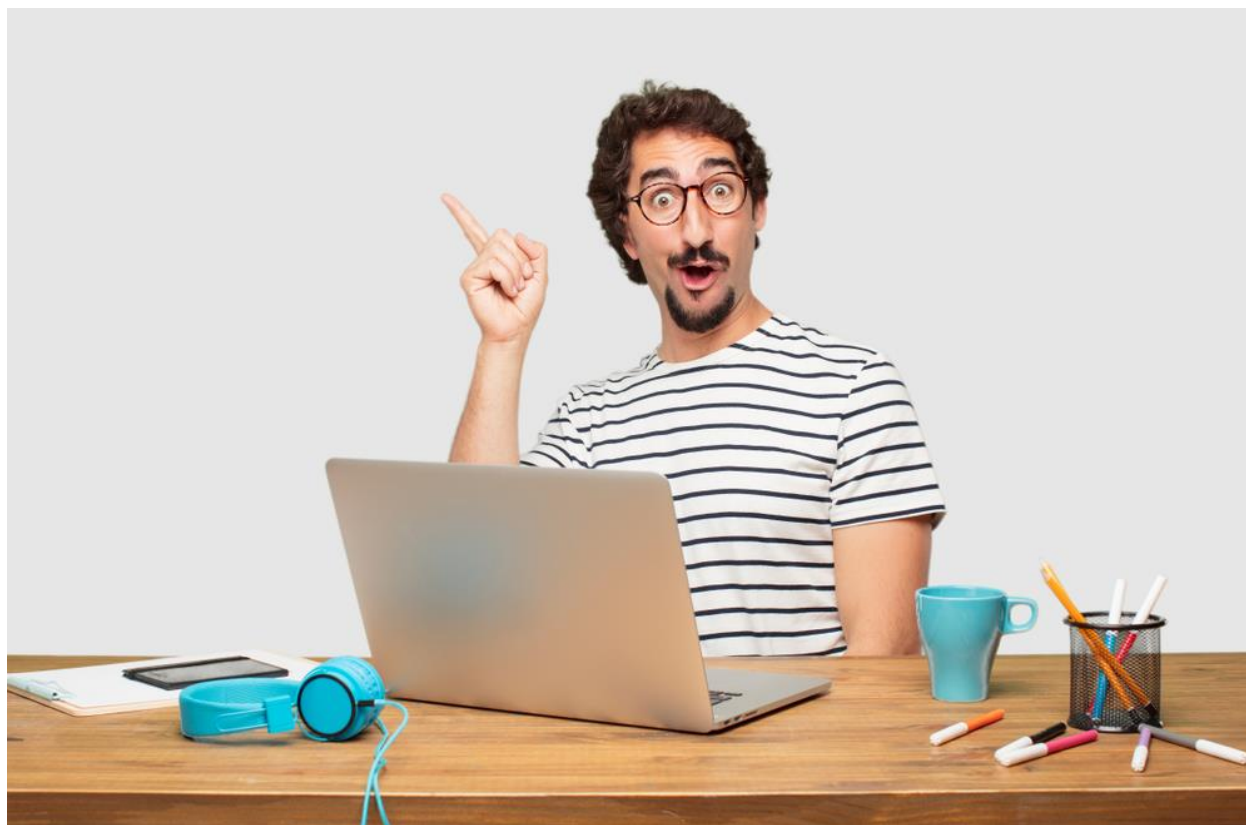
**still**

**much**

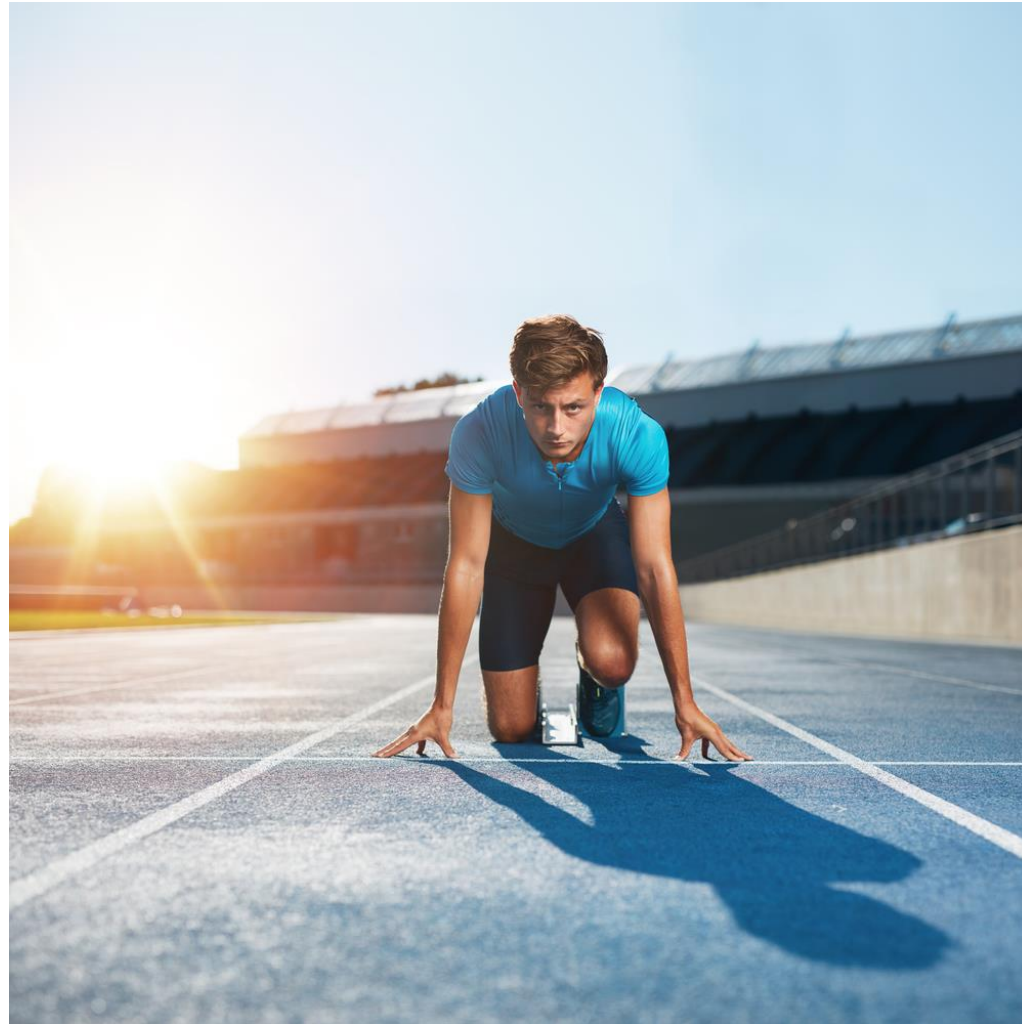
**Thank you very much!**

right.**





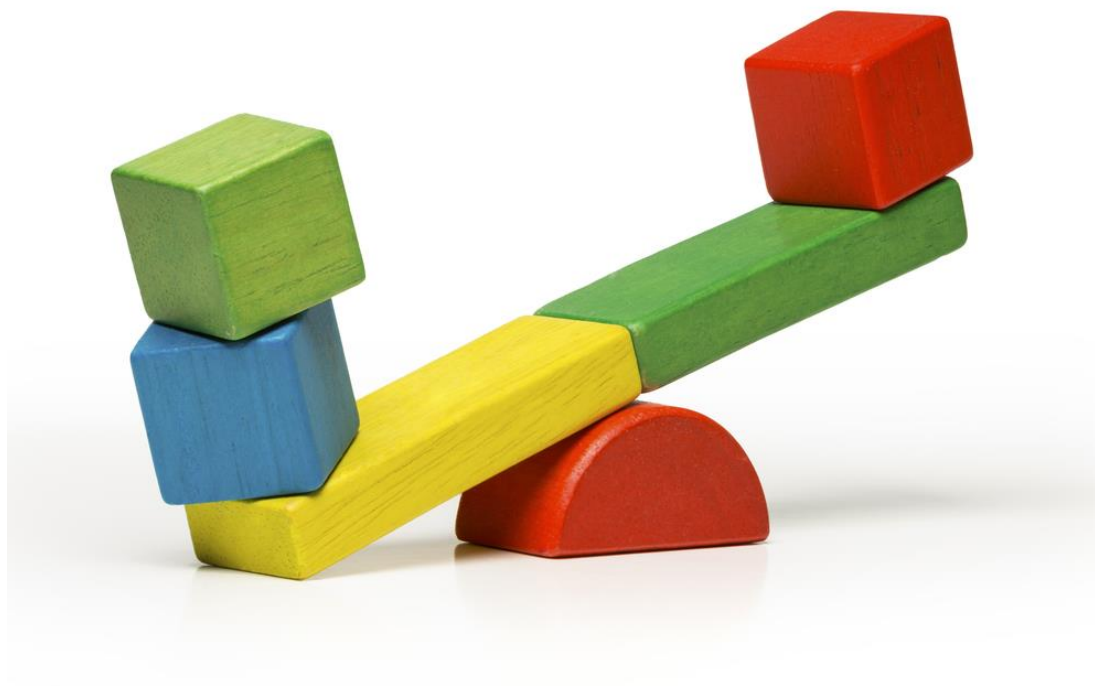
**guess**

**touch**

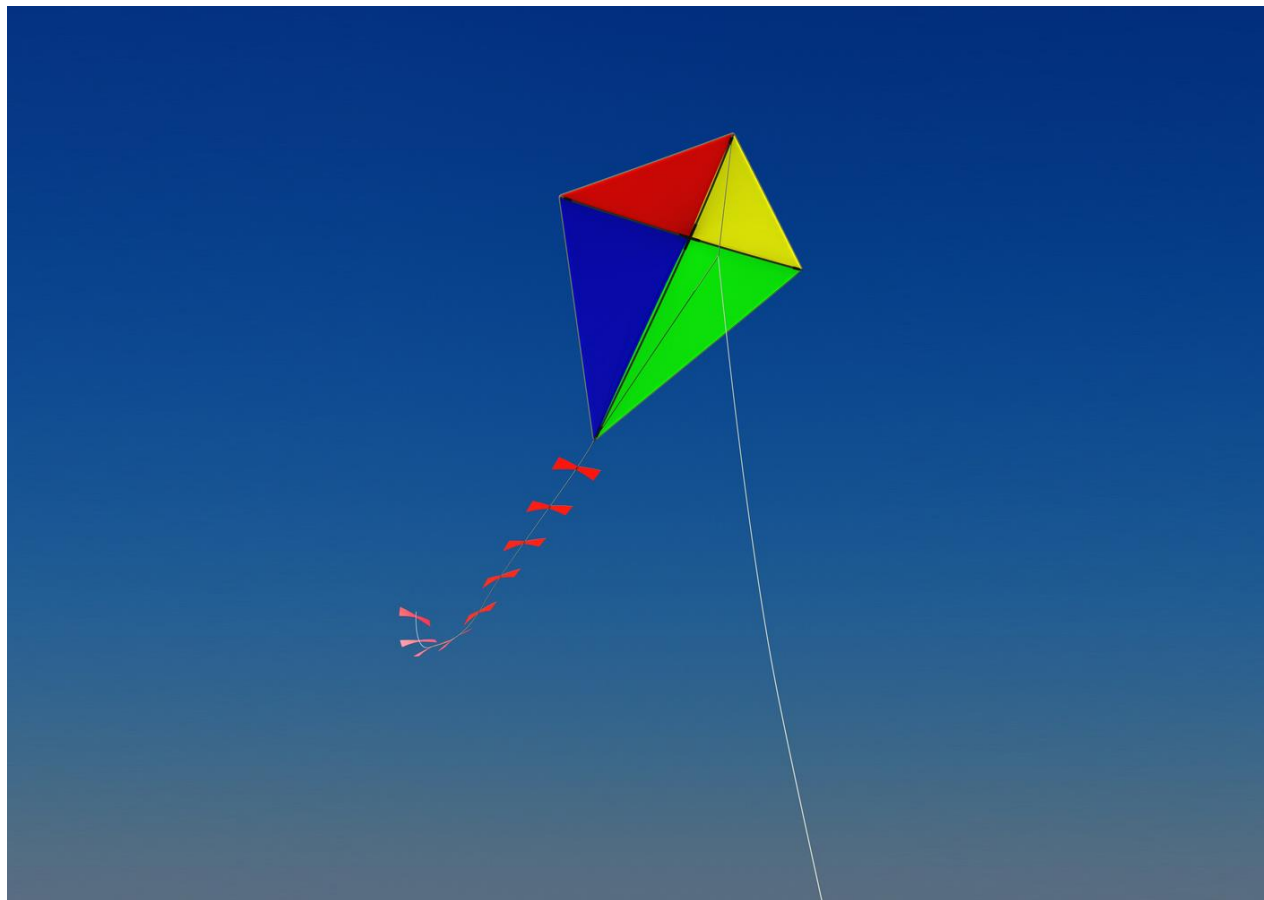
**I wanted to touch it.**
